



Metformin for Overweight & Obese Children and Adolescents with Bipolar Spectrum Disorders Treated with Second-Generation Antipsychotics

Participants Needed!

- **What:** A study to determine if a lifestyle intervention or a lifestyle intervention plus metformin helps children and teens prevent or reverse weight gain caused by certain medications.
- **Who:** Children and teens ages 8-17 years who have a mood disorder, are overweight, and are currently taking a second-generation antipsychotic or may start taking them.
- **Where:** Visits take place in the patient's mental health clinic during their regularly scheduled appointments.
- **Payment:** Compensation up to \$155 for patients and their caregivers may be available for time and travel.
