

FY 2018 Awards, Events, and Funding Opportunities

Bridge Funding Program

*Applications due: December 4, 2017 and April 16, 2018

The Bridge Funding Program was established to provide short-term bridge- or “gap”- funding for productive CoM researchers who have had previous NIH funding, and who have remained active in research and in submitting grant applications, but who are now between funding cycles.

Citizenship/Research Service Award

*Applications due: May 7, 2018

This award recognizes a faculty member for exceptional service to our research mission.

Core Enhancement Funding Program

*Applications due: November 13, 2017

The purpose of the Core Enhancement funding program is to provide existing core laboratories with resources to continue to evolve their technologies and advance the core support capabilities offered to our research community.

Grant Pre-Review

*Rolling Deadline: Faculty may submit grants to be reviewed at any time during the year.

However, applications need to be submitted 60 days prior to the actual grant deadline to allow for a thoughtful review and time to respond to the suggestions by the reviewers. CoM Grant Pre-Review Program supports the refinement of scientific projects and grantsmanship of proposals from CoM faculty prior to official submission of a grant application to a funding agency with this mechanism.

Research Innovation Award

*Applications due: April 30, 2018

The Research Innovation Grant Program was established to assist College of Medicine investigators with generating the preliminary data necessary to develop highly competitive grant applications or to take their research in a new direction.

Research Recognition Awards Program

*Event date: November 15, 2017

This program recognizes College of Medicine researchers who have received external funding in the previous fiscal year and all internal grant awardees.

Research Rising Star Award

*Applications due: January 8, 2018

This is awarded to an Instructor or Assistant Professor who demonstrates outstanding research accomplishments and impact at the early career stage.

Team Science Research Award

*Applications due: September 25, 2017

This will be awarded to a team of faculty members who have successfully created and sustained a multidisciplinary research team that significantly contributes to the mission of the College.
