WIMS EXECUTIVE MEMBER POSTITION DESCRIPTIONS

President:

The duties of the WIMS president include:

- 1. establishing and maintaining relationships with CoM leadership, including the CoM Dean, assistant-associate deans, and department chairs (clinical and basic science).
- 2. hearing / identifying needs of CoM women faculty and creating working groups to promote or facilitate the implementation of programming or policies to address these needs.
- 3. providing resources and leadership support for WIMS working groups, including establishing regular meetings with the UCCoM dean.

Secretary:

Working in conjunction with the executive committee, the duties of the WIMS secretary include activity surrounding the monthly WIMS executive meetings and separate large group meetings, such as: drafting agendas, recording minutes, and following up with issues raised during the meetings. The secretary will also communicate to the WIMS membership (via email and/or social media) with reminders of events and opportunities.

Treasurer:

Working in conjunction with the executive committee, the duties of the WIMS treasurer include knowledge and management of the two account strings associated with our organization: (1) the WIMS general fund (used for awards, invited speakers, food for seminars, etc.) and (2) the "Lift While You Climb" WIMS endowment (to be used explicitly as a monetary award for a WIMS member that demonstrates significant impact on the mentorship and sponsorship of women in the COM). The treasurer will also work to identify potential areas for donor support and create opportunities for fundraising for these two funds.
