

Self Screening for Employees

If your temperature reading is **100.0 degrees or higher** – No further steps are needed. Follow the directions below

- You must stay home and notify your manager.
 - If you are concerned about your symptoms please send an email to COVIDWatch@uc.edu

If your temperature reading is **99.9 degrees or lower** – Continue with the screening questions below

Screening Questions / Actions:

- 1. Have you had/have a new onset of cough, fever or shortness of breath not related to seasonal allergies?
 - No → Continue screening
 - Yes → You should stay home and notify your manager. If you are concerned about your symptoms please send an email to COVIDWatch@uc.edu
- 2. Have you had a confirmed exposure to COVID-19?
 - No → You pass the screening and are able to come to work.
 - Yes \rightarrow You must answer the following questions:
 - a. Were you wearing appropriate PPE when you were exposed?
 - Yes → You pass the screning and are able to come to work. No/Unsure → Follow up Question
 - b. Have you spoken with your Manager/Employee Health and been cleared to return to work?
 - Yes → You pass the screening and are able to come to work
 - No → You must stay at home and notify your manager and send an email to COVIDWatch@uc.edu to report a potential COVID-19 exposure.

When you come to work you need to bring a mask to wear while on campus
