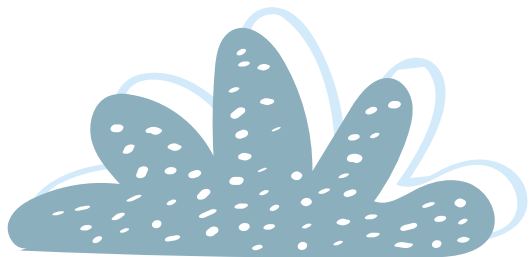

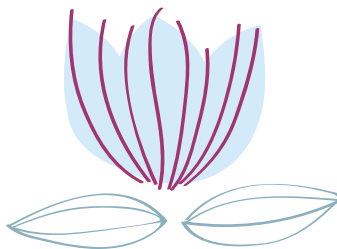

PLATFORM POINTS....EXPLAINED



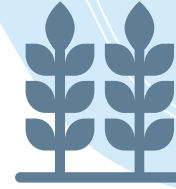
Collaboration
